ORDER

The Planning Commission, Government of India have sanctioned a scheme relating to the establishment of a Centre for Performing Arts at Varkala at a cost of Rs. 10 Crore (Rupees Ten Crore Only) during 2012-13 under One Time Additional Central Assistance (ACA). As per the Government Order read as 1st paper above, Government have accorded Administrative Sanction for Rs. 10 Crore for setting up the Centre for Performing Arts at Varkala. The implementation period of the project is 2 years. As per the Government Order read as 2nd paper above, Administrative Sanction was accorded to release an amount of Rs. 4 Crore for the implementation of the project under the Head of Account "5452-80-104-99(Plan)".

2. As per the Government Order read as 3rd paper above, Government have accorded revised Administrative Sanction for Rs. 10 Crore under the Head of Account "5452-80-104-99(Plan) - Centre for Performing Arts at Varkala (One Time ACA)" for the scheme, Centre for Performing Arts at Varkala for a further period of two years, since the validity period of the project was over,

3. Subsequently as per the Note read as 4th paper above, the Chief Technical Examiner & Ex-officio Special Secretary to Government, Finance (Inspection-Technical-Wing) Department scrutinized the Technical Sanction proposal and made certain observations on the proposal.


4. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord Technical Sanction for the scheme, Centre for Performing Arts at Varkala, subject to the following conditions;

1. Certificate to the effect that 'observed data/local market rates were adopted only for non-scheduled items' and 'local market rates adopted are the lowest rates prevailing in the locality' shall be furnished by HLL.
2. While tendering, item rate contract method shall be adopted. The tender shall be supplied with BOQ which contains items with approximate quantities.
3. Contingencies/unforeseen items shall be deleted from Technical Sanction proposal.
4. Any deviations in the specification/quantities of items are not permitted during execution without the prior approval of Government.
5. After incorporating the above details in the proposal, a copy of the abstract of estimate should be forwarded to Government and the Chief Technical Examiner & Ex-officio Special Secretary to Government, Finance (Inspection-Technical-Wing) Department after complying the above.
